## SSS - Report 2020-21

The following summary points extracted from the SSS 2020-21. There were 153 respondents. 21 questions were asked, mostly with five point scale ratings was followed.

- **1. STUDENTS SATISFIED WITH**: Teachers' preparation, communicate well in class and syllabus completion, institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow, mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to you, teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications, teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities.
- **2. STUDENTS NEED SUPPORT IN**: Approach to teaching, teachers use ICT tools, Efforts are made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employ-ability skills to make you ready for the world of work, institute/ teachers use student centric methods, performance in assignments, institution facilitates you in cognitive, identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of challenges, Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them, social and emotional growth Fairness of the internal evaluation process was well was widely found to be satisfactory
- **3. SUGGESTIONS FROM STUDENTS ABOUT INSTITUTION**: Students were mostly satisfied by the college and few notable suggestions were made to incorporate research activities, placements . students appreciated offline classes over online classes.

The above diagrams reveal that the 75% students agreed that 'the institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow'. 58.6% of students responded are of the opinion that 'then institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning processes'. Keeping in view the above diagrams, it becomes evident that computer labs, are not satisfactory.

After analyzed the responses of students and teachers, the IQAC have framed the report. The feedback report framed was submitted in a meeting called by Principal of the college in Meeting Hall and there a discussion and deliberation was held regarding the feedback responses of the stakeholders.
