There are a number of risks while using gas such as explosion from leakage, over heated or improperly used cylinders, also the risk of Carbone Monoxide poisoning and burns caused by contact with flame.

Safety measures:

- *Don't use match box or candle to look for leaks
- *Don't turn on electric switches on or off Do not store flammable materials such as papers, tissues match boxes etc.,
- *in emergency turn off regulator and call your gas agency staff
- * Don't place cylinder inside an enclosed compartment.



Out comes:

- *Students learned how to approach people and how to speak and how to convince them
- *Households listened our suggestions and agreed to follow the instructions given by students and staff

Giving awareness on Child marriage Act:

Department of Telugu along with students went to prasanthinagar, Chittoor to give awareness on child marriage Act. In Prasanthnagar most of the people are uneducated, labors working on daily wages. They perform marriages to their children before the age of 18. Our students tell them the effects of child marriages. They told that you do marriges in early age they likely have early pregnencies, they may face dangerous complications in child birth, and also experience domestic violence. Ending child marriages improve girl child's health we will save their lives.
